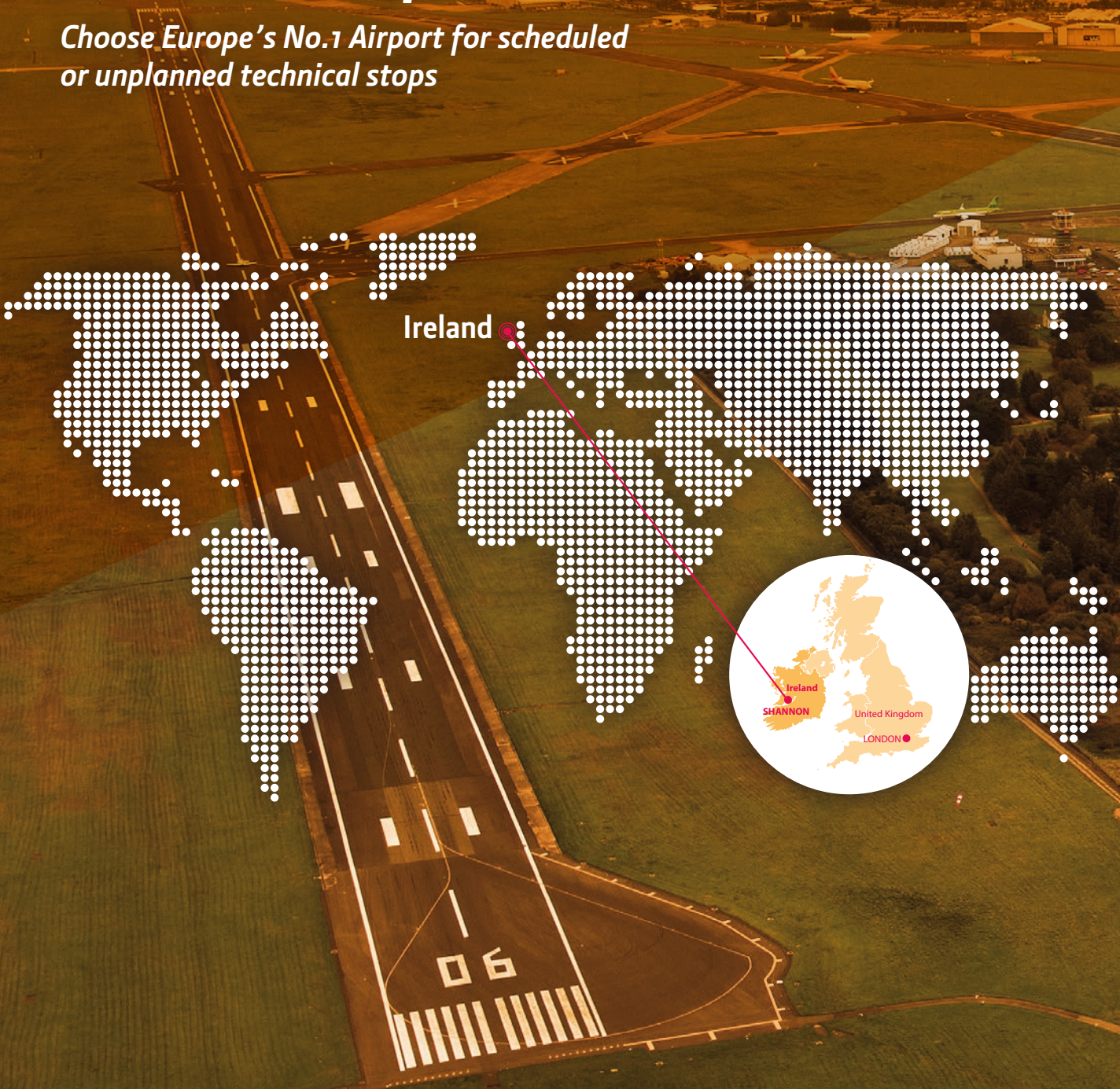

Technical Overview

- ✈ Shannon (SNN/EINN) is a long-standing transatlantic transit stop which offers excellent facilities
- ✈ Shannon has the longest runway in Ireland (3,200m)
- ✈ Shannon benefits from efficient and uncongested facilities and a superb weather record
- ✈ North Atlantic Air Traffic Control is based in Shannon: westbound departing flights have direct access to optimum transatlantic tracks and levels (saving fuel and time)
- ✈ Shannon Airport offers a 24-hour operation 365 days a year with dedicated transit facilities, quick turnarounds and short taxi time
- ✈ Choice of experienced FBO's and Aircraft Handling Companies make for quick turnarounds and very competitive pricing
- ✈ US Customs and Immigration (CBP) preclearance facility for scheduled services, transit operations and Business Jet flights
- ✈ Shannon is the only airport in Ireland that remains open all year round. It is unhampered by operational or local authority restrictions. No restrictive noise abatement procedures apply day or night
- ✈ Competitive fuel pricing and handling charges. Excellent quality and affordable crew hotels. Local MROs licensed to provide engineering cover
- ✈ Shannon is the only airport in Ireland with a dedicated aviation fuel hydrant system offering a 24 hour/365 days fuelling service for aircraft. The aviation fuel storage facility is the largest airport storage facility within the state and can hold 50+ days stock

- ✈ Capable of handling all aircraft types
- ✈ Main European airport for transatlantic Business Aviation technical stops
